

 - d.) What is the door material?
- 2. What is the door opening width?
- 3. Is there wall space immediately adjacent to the door opening on both sides?

If so, how much?

- 4. What is the height above the door opening?
- 5. What is the hardware mounted to? Framed wall, glass, steel, concrete?
- 6. Does the opening have door trim? If so, how thick is it?
- 7. Does the wall have base molding? If so, how thick is it (including base shoe if applicable)?
- 8. Are there any other protruding wall elements along the length of the installation?
- 9. Which hardware is preferred?
 - a.) Loki, Oden or Baldur system?
 - b.) Top Mount, Face Mount, or Glass Mount?
 - c.) Which finish?
- 10. Will you be using a door pull? If so,
 - a.) Single or double-sided?
 - b.) What is the make and model?
- 11. Is there a perpendicular wall or any other obstruction immediately adjacent to this door installation? If so,
 - a.) What type?
 - b.) Where is it located?
